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A BIBLIOGRAPHY OF SYSTEMATIC REFERENCES TO THE GREY MULLET (MUGILIDAE)

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Summary

This bibliography lists the 281 specific names that have been applied to extant Mugilidae, of these 70 are recognised as valid species and 32 are of doubtful status. All known taxonomic works that have used a particular specific name are listed under that name by means of a code number referring to the bibliographic table proper which lists 696 published papers and books. Under each publication is listed the species included by means of code numbers referring to the species list. An indication of published figures is given in the species list.

I. INTRODUCTION

The systematic literature of any large group of animals is well scattered and a considerable proportion of it may be in obscure journals, not readily available for consultation in many libraries. As a result many references may be overlooked, and it is significant that many of the older publications seldom get mention in modern reference lists. This compilation of references to the Mugilidae is offered for the use of taxonomists and of those concerned with problems of distribution of mugilid species.

II. ARRANGEMENT

The bibliography is not a bare list of authors' names and the titles of papers. An indication is given of the specific names dealt with in each work and where a description is given

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this fact is indicated. To increase the usefulness of the references, the designation of nominate species by the names considered by the present author to be valid is given in List 1. It is unlikely that all these designations will be acceptable to all experts, but a bibliography, annotated or otherwise, is not the place to justify judgements of taxonomic status. All designations are thus provisional as far as this listing is concerned.

The 281 nominate species of mugilid are listed below in alphabetical order of trivial names. The trivial name is followed by the genetic name used by the original author, followed by that author's name and the date of publication. Then follows the specific name considered valid by the present author.

Under each trivial name are listed by number, referring to the bibliographic list (List 2) below, the publications in which the trivial name has been used. Where the trivial name has been used in error for a species other than the one originally designated this is indicated by a separate listing under the same list number followed by the post-script "A" etc., together with the presumed correct identity of the species. Where a preoccupied name has been used for a presumed new species, a separate number is listed. If a figure was published this is indicated immediately after the reference list number by the letter (F). Variations in spelling are indicated in brackets after the trivial name, but no attempt has been made to show which authors have used the variants.

Following the species list is the bibliographic list in alphabetical order of authors' names, each reference being preceded by a serial number which is the cross-reference to the lists under the trivial names. After the publication reference the species included are indicated by means of numbers referring to the serial prescript numbers in List 1. A publication in which there is a species list without descriptions is indicated by an asterisk before the list of index numbers indicating the species; if only some of the species listed are without descriptions these are indicated by an asterisk immediately after the appropriate index number.

Some of the publications listed have not been available for consultation and an indication of these is made. In these cases the species list has been compiled from the synonymy lists of other authors and therefore may in some cases be incomplete. A brief annotation is given after some publications, but these have been kept to a minimum.
